



THE DEN

The Den, our Kids Club at Six Senses Laamu, offers the junior guests an unforgettable experience during their stay at the resort.

We are open from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm and from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm every day and children between the ages of 3 – 12 years are welcome to join the activity program. Children less than 3 years are always welcome with their parents, guardian or babysitter.

Parents are requested to fill-out a registration form for each child, giving basic information about him/her. The Den also offers baby-sitting service in the villa during the day and also after The Den is closed. Baby-sitting charge is USD 15 per hour per child. Each additional child will be charged USD 5 per hour per child. These are subject to 10 percent service charge and 8 percent GST (Good and Service Tax) .

The Den has a Book Zone, (to chill out) a Yum Zone (for a quick snack), an Expression Zone (to show what children have done), Cinema Zone, (to watch a movie) an Art and Craft Zone (to bring out the creativity of the children) and a Sleep Zone (to snooze after a long day of enjoyment).

Den activities vary between water play, outdoor play, indoor play and art and craft. The children will have the opportunity of swimming in the clear blue waters, building sand castles, climbing ropes, swinging from a monkey bar, go on a swing, play football, cricket or even frisbee throwing when they are outdoors. There are outdoor games like hide-and-seek, pizza ball, pyramids and water relay to name a few.

If the sun is too hot to play outside, the children can enjoy the activities indoors such as board games, building blocks, darts with magnets, dominoes and also play some musical instruments.

There is a range of art and craft planned out for each day of the week. The children can make a jelly fish, make pictures with hand prints, flip flops for fun, make jewelry out of paper beads and even make a sail boat. Most of the craft is made using recycled material.
